Sulfates have been shown to play an increasingly important role in many biochemical processes. New synthetic methods for the synthesis of sulfates are described. These compounds are then used to probe the role of sulfates and sulfation in a variety of processes including breast cancer growth and the mechanism of aryl sulfatases.
